

Smoking policy

Providers must ensure that children are in a smoke free environment,

We recognise that many people in our society smoke. We are aware that smoking is an activity disapproved of by many parents and to which they do not wish their child to be exposed.

All staff and volunteers are made aware at their initial interview that it is against the law to smoke within the nursery (and any other working environment). Therefore smoking is not permitted in any area within the nursery or its grounds. Smoking is not permitted whilst staff and volunteers are on nursery outings with the children. All staff and volunteers are required to sign to say they agree to abide by this policy.

We have a 'No Smoking' sign displayed on the main entrance gate so that all visitors are aware that they are not permitted to smoke on the premises. We also have this information in our school brochure, which parents are given upon their initial induction.
