



Week Beginning: 22nd January 2018

Theme: Transport

Monday: In the morning, we will attend forest school and make bird feeders. In the afternoon we will take part in name writing, role play on the rocket ship, and discuss different modes of transport.

Tuesday: In the morning, we will match transport, do some building outside and focus on our sound of the week. In the afternoon we will cut out some transport, focus on our number of the week and play 'What's the time Mr Wolf?'

Wednesday: In the morning, we will junk model some cars, use the tractors and go karts, and take part in show and tell. In the afternoon we will look at the sounds in our names, sing wheels on the bus, and take part in show and tell.

Thursday: In the morning we will make the Scottish flag, have a horse race, and discuss Scotland. In the afternoon we will go bird watching, at forest school and listen to Scottish music.

Friday: In the morning, we will make a race track, pretend to be different transport, and learn about the birds. In the afternoon we will have story time, play follow the leader, and sing transport songs.
