



Week Beginning: 22nd January 2018

Theme: Transport

Monday: In the morning we will focus on pencil control, we will discuss how we get around, and pretend fly. In the afternoon we will search for the letter 't', have music time and practice our running.

Tuesday: In the morning we will attend forest school and go bird watching, and sing jolly phonics. In the afternoon we will observe what sinks and floats, ride on the tractors, and make a track to race on.
