



Week Beginning: 9th July 2018

Theme: Music and Dance

Monday: In the morning we will read our book of the week "The Usborne Board Book". We will continue working on the sunflower life cycle and complete our class display.

In the afternoon we will work as a whole group practicing our Makaton songs and singing along. We will then break into small groups and work on our phonic word building activities. We will then work on a craft activity exploring seeds and shrubs.

Tuesday: In the morning We will sing some of our favourite songs and explore some musical instruments. We will then make some musical instruments using junk modelling materials (kazoo, shakers, drums and drumsticks).

In the afternoon we will work in small groups on our number recognition and play some simple addition/subtraction games. We will then working on following shapes and patterns to make musical tunes.

Wednesday: In the morning we will practice our letter recognition using a phonics cd. We will then be drawing shape names and counting sides. We will make some chocolate crispy treats.

In the afternoon we will read our book of the week "The Usborne Board Book". We will then be going to Forest School where we will continue making musical instruments using various resources. We will also re-enact the story of the three Billy Goats Gruff using props.

Thursday: In the morning we will have a musical instrument themed show and Tell. We will then break into smaller groups and practice letter formation using a variety of mark making resources.

In the afternoon we will continue with our musical instrument themed show and tell. We will then use the sand tray to practice writing numbers 5 - 10 before free painting numbers on a class mural.

Friday: In the morning we will clap out rhythm and rhyme as a whole group. We will then go to Forest School. We will make some collages using natural resources and learn the song "The Teddy Bear's Picnic".

In the afternoon we will use the class tablet to listen to various musical instruments from around the world. We will then experiment with sounds using our multi-cultural instruments. We will play some musical games such as musical chairs, Musical Bumps, Musical statues etc.
