



Week Beginning: 9th July 2018

Theme: Music and Dance

Monday: In the morning we will be looking at our book of the week "The Big Keyboard Book". We will then work in small groups to practice our pencil control. We will clap out some rhythms using the musical instruments. In the afternoon We will play an eye spy letter game. We will then go to Forest School where we will be painting our own wooden drumsticks and tapping out rhythms on the tree stumps.

Tuesday: In the morning we will be counting out numbers from 1 - 20 and looking at flash cards for recognition of numbers up to 30. We will then be using a variety of junk modelling resources to make musical instruments.. In the afternoon we will be encouraging the children to play some games such as musical bumps, musical statues and pass the parcel etc. The children will control the operation buttons on the music player. We be singing our Jolly Phonic songs and working in small groups to begin word building.

Wednesday: In the morning we will be working as a whole group on phonic blending and focussing on words containing the "ch" sound. We will be going to Forest School where we will play some listening games and drawing pictures of what we can hear. We will also learn the "Teddy Bear's Picnic" song and have a picnic.

Thursday: In the morning we will be singing our favourite nursery rhymes as a whole group. We will then be working in small groups to practice our letter formation. In the afternoon we will watch a video about musical instruments from various countries around the world. We will play a matching musical instrument naming game. We will make up our own dance routines.

Friday: In the morning we will have a musical instrument themed show and tell. We will then work in small groups to play letters and sounds games. We will do some singing and dancing to our favourite songs. In the afternoon we will make some jam tarts. We will then hold a dance party and watch some videos of different types of dancing from around the world.
