



Week Beginning: 9<sup>th</sup> July 2018

Theme: Music and Dance

**Monday:** In the morning we will discuss the rules at Forest School and how they help us to keep safe. We will then learn the "Teddy Bear's Picnic" song and have our own Teddy Bear's Picnic at Forest School. We will re-enact the three Billy Goat's Gruff on our new bridge.

In the afternoon we will explore a variety of musical instruments and learn their names. We will then take turns to play our keyboard book and pretend to be a marching band outside.

**Tuesday:** In the morning we will clap out the syllables in our name during whole group time. We will then make some rainbow tambourines using paper plates and bells.

In the afternoon we will sing some songs using Makaton signs. We will then play a fun musical guessing game: "name that instrument".

**Wednesday:** In the morning we will hold a musical instrument themed show and tell. We will then take part in a craft activity decorating guitars whilst listening to guitar music.

In the afternoon we will hold a musical instrument themed show and tell. We will then draw our own musical instruments symbols and practice our pencil control.

**Thursday:** In the morning we will we will explore different ways of dancing as a whole group activity. We will then practice writing our names ready for school and make some chocolate rice crispy cakes.

In the afternoon we will go to Forest School. We will paint some drumsticks and tap out some rhythms on the tree stumps.

**Friday:** In the morning we work on our sound of the week "d". We will also be looking at clips of music on the tablet and discussing how it makes us feel and painting mood pictures.

In the afternoon we will practice our Rainbow song. We will then make a den in the classroom and practice reading stories.
