



Week Beginning: 17th September 2018

Theme: Favourite rhymes

Monday: During our circle time this morning we will read the book of the week "People of the World". We will also sing our rhyme of the week "Dingle Dangle Scarecrow" We will get creative making superhero masks and think about superhero names.

In the afternoon we will be working on our sound of the week "t", we will work on our fine motor development and practice threading a letter "t" stencil.

Tuesday: In the morning we will discuss harvest time and the different foods associated with harvest. We will talk about harvest from around the world and begin a class can drive. We will practice recognising and writing the letters in our name and work on a maths project ordering objects into sets of 2's.

In the morning we will practice some Makaton signs whilst singing our favourite rhymes. We will make a class poster for our can drive display and work in small groups to complete challenging puzzles.

Wednesday: In the morning we will play a "guess that musical instrument" game. We will then discuss different vegetable and how they are grown and harvested. We will make some vegetable soup to try in class.

In the afternoon we will read our book of the week "the people of the World". We will then go out to Forest School and plant some daffodil bulbs.

Thursday: This morning we will do a "favourite rhyme" themed show and tell. We will then work in small groups in recognising the letter "i". We will decorate an igloo and practice writing the letters "t" and "i".

In the afternoon we will continue with our favourite rhyme themed show and tell. We will then get creative and work on some junk modelling designs. We will go on a bug hunt outside.

Friday: In the morning we will sing some harvest themed rhymes. We will then go out to Forest School and plant some daffodil bulbs ready for Spring time, we will also experiment with bark rubbing and wax crayons.

In the afternoon we will sing our favourite rhymes. We will continue practicing our letter formation for letters "t" and "i" and complete this project work. The children will also play with some animals encased in ice and discuss the concept of melting and change.
