



Week Beginning: 17th September 2018

Theme: Favourite rhymes and stories

Monday: During our whole group time this morning we will sing some of our favourite rhymes. We will then go out to forest school and plant some daffodil bulbs ready for Spring time. We will go on a flower hunt and see if we can name the flowers growing now.

In the afternoon we will have a group discussion about what we did at the weekend. We will then work in small groups to make some hand puppets on sticks, we will then read stories and use our puppets as props.

Tuesday: During our whole group time this morning we will be looking closely at our number of the week "2". We will also talk about harvest and where the different foods we eat come from. We will then make a poster for our "can drive" and join in with some action songs and rhymes.

In the afternoon we will make a class band and explore our musical instruments. We will then identify various vegetables and make a vegetable soup to taste in the classroom.

Wednesday: During our whole group time this morning we will show and tell our favourite stories. We will then read stories in small groups and make some vegetable print pictures.

In the afternoon we will continue with our Show and Tell favourite stories. We will then play some game which help us to recognise the letter sounds in our name.

Thursday: During our circle time this morning we will work on our sound of the week "b". We will then play a game using the conversation cubes to promote language and communication development.

In the afternoon we will go out to Forest School and plant some more daffodil bulbs. We will also role play the 3 Billy Goats Gruff using various props.

Friday: During our circle time this morning we will sing a song "Ms Gemma has a bag..." guess the farm animal game. We will read and act out the "Animal BoP Book". Each child will make an animal face mask.

In the afternoon we will go out on a shape hunt and look out for shapes in the environment. We will use the Hungry Caterpillar sack and make some Butterfly symmetry pictures to take home.
