



Week Beginning: 17th September 2018 Theme: Favourite Rhymes

Monday: During circle time this morning we will sing some of our favourite rhymes and learn some of the Makaton signs that go with them. We will then work on our pencil control and trace some templates and follow the dots. In the afternoon we will join together to do some action songs and dancing. We will then look at shapes and see if the children can copy them on the white board.

Tuesday: In the morning we will sing our Jolly phonics together. We will then go out to Forest School and look for signs of Autumn. We will talk about the seasons and plant some daffodil bulbs ready for the Spring. In circle time this afternoon we will look at a book about feelings, and learn about them. We will do some vegetable printing and learn about patterns. We will then do some singing and dancing in the group.

Wednesday: In our circle time this morning we will play some eye spy games and think about the letter sounds of items we can see and focus on the initial sounds in children's names. We will then work in small groups and practice putting the letter sounds in our name in the correct order. In the afternoon we will read our book of the week "The Smallest Giant in Town". We will then make a poster for our class can drive and work in small groups to learn some Makaton signs.

Thursday: In our circle time this morning we will do some action songs of the children's choice. We will then work in smaller groups to practice writing the number "3" and counting out matching numbers up to "3". In the afternoon we will play a game of "Guess that vegetable". We will then sing some more songs using Makaton signs. We will work in small groups to play a number snap game.

Friday: In the morning we will learn about harvesting and being thankful for our food. We will talk to the children about our can drive. We will then work in smaller groups to play with the rainbow sorting crayons to help us learn our colour names. We will make a vegetable soup. In the afternoon we will do a show and tell of the children's favourite stories from home. We will then go out to Forest School and plant some daffodil bulbs we will also make some collages using natural materials.
