



Week Beginning: 5th November 2018

Theme: Fireworks



Monday: This morning we will discuss Bonfire night and who is going to go see them tonight. What do we need to keep us safe? In small groups we will use coloured paint to create a firework picture. After this the children will be making necklaces by threading pasta onto string.

In the afternoon we will be learning about Guy Fawkes and why we celebrate it each year, we will use the tablet to watch a short video clip about this.

The children will be creating rockets using junk modelling items like, kitchen roll tubes, bottle lids, pots, foil, tissue paper etc. In small groups we will be making an umbrella and we will be writing the letter 'U'.

Tuesday: As we have been working on creating fireworks and also having been to displays the children will be listening to a story called 'The Fire Fly story'. Alongside this we will be discussing fire safety. In small groups this morning we will be creating a plan of a house which we will then construct out of bricks. The children will also be able to create a unicorn plus write the letter 'U' on white boards.

In the afternoon we will sing our favourite nursery rhyme songs to the class, the children will each take a turn for this activity. We will be working on finishing our Bonfire display board today.

Wednesday: As a class this morning we will play a game of 'Mrs Brown has a box', each child will get a turn to do this.

Each child will be making a poppy; we will use red tissue paper and black card. The children will be working on their scissor control for this.

This afternoon is forest school, the children will have the chance to make bird feeders using pipe cleaners, cheerio's and pine cones. We will be discussing Remembrance Sunday and we will be watching a short video clip about this.

Thursday: Today is 'Show and tell' day. The children are welcome to bring in anything they would like to share with the class. In small groups we will be working on our second sound of the week which is 'O'. We will be creating an owl using craft materials.

In the afternoon we will think of words that start with the letters 'O' and 'U'. We will try to draw pictures and write labels.

Friday: To start this morning's session the children will be listening to our book of the week which is 'Christopher Nibble'. We have forest school this morning where the children will be creating bird feeders using pipe cleaners and cheerio's. The children will each put these on branches for the birds.

During the afternoon session we will be practising our sound recognition by using the jolly phonics book. In small groups we will be making lavender bags and creating some remembrance poppies.
