



Week Beginning: 26<sup>th</sup> November 2018

Theme: Sending Letters

**Monday:** During circle time this morning we will read our book of the week "Dear Zoo". We will then work on the letter sound "z" and play a matching zoo animal game. We will then be decorating a Christmas tree for our role play area. In the afternoon we will be looking at transport. We will also be making an aeroplane using junk modelling materials.

**Tuesday:** In the morning we will play some simple word building games and work on cvc phonics. We will then make some Zebras and practice counting using our Wiggly worms.

In the afternoon we will sing some number songs together as a whole group. We will then talk about people who are special to us and make some thank you cards.

**Wednesday:** We will begin the day by visiting the Alpacas with Mr John. We will read the story "The Jolly Postman" and then make a class post box so that we can post our letters to Santa. We will look through toy catalogues to get some gift ideas.

In the afternoon we will learn some Makaton signs. We will then go out to Forest School. We will make a collage using different naturally found resources.

**Thursday:** In the morning we will do our show and tell - please bring in a post card or letter from home. We will then look at some alpaca fleece and make some pictures of Alpacas using the fleece.

In the afternoon we will repeat our shown and tell activity. We will then look at our 2<sup>nd</sup> letter of the week which is "w". We will construct some junk model windmills.

**Friday:** In the morning we will sing our Jolly phonic songs. We will then go out to Forest School and create a bug hotel.

In the afternoon we will read our book of the week "Dear Zoo". We will then use some felt tip pens to create Price and princess dresses.
