



Week Beginning: 14th January 2019

Theme - Favourite rhymes

Monday: This morning we will be having a visit from Mr John and Charlie the rabbit. We will talk about what Charlie needs for food and how we should look after him. This morning we have forest school. The children will have the opportunity to make an animal home. We will use natural resources to do this. This afternoon as a group we will look at our initial sounds. We will also look at our sounds of the week which are 'S' and 'A'. Our adult focus activity is to focus on shape recognition, we will be playing a game in small groups.

Tuesday: Today we will be playing noisy neighbour. The children will try to guess what sound is being made. For our adult focus activity we will bake bread rolls. We will be learning the song 'pat-a-cake' to sing when making the bread. This afternoon we will be using Makaton signing songs to learn our nursery rhymes as a whole group. Following this the children will be encouraged to look at their sounds using flashcards to help support them.

Wednesday: Today is show and tell day. The children will be encouraged to bring into class something to do with nursery rhymes e.g. toy, book or CD. This morning we will be focussing on our scissor control, we will be using humpty-dumpty worksheet to do this. In the afternoon we will use musical instruments to tap out rhymes. Will the children be able to tell what song is being played?

Thursday: To start our day we will be singing Makaton signing rhymes together as a group. As our adult focus activity we will be making puppets from our favourite nursery rhymes. The children can use a variety of materials to do this. This afternoon we have our forest school session. The children will be making hibernation houses either for squirrels, hedgehog or badgers. We will use natural resources to do this.

Friday: To start our session we will be playing a group a cvc game. The children will be learning to sound out words like m-a-t and c-a-t. To help the children with their shape recognition we will be playing a game of shape snap. The children will sit in small groups and will have adult to support them. We will be looking at our number of the week this afternoon which is '2'. In small groups we will be making little ducks using tissue paper. A variety of materials will be available to the children so they can add anything they would like to create something beautiful.
