



Week Beginning: 5th November 2018

Theme: Fireworks

Monday: Today is forest school morning; we will be making lavender bags and bird feeders. We will be using pipe cleaners and cheerio's to do this. We will hang the bird feeders in the trees.

During our afternoon session we will be discussing firework safety. We will watch a short video clip to help us to understand this better. Following this we will be creating firework patterns; we will use bright colours for this.

Tuesday: We will be singing '5 little firefighters' as a class this morning. As our adult focus activity we will be making kitchen roll rockets. We will use paint, foil, card and tissue paper.

During the afternoon we will play a little game of 'Simon says'. Will the children be listening to the correct instructions? This afternoon we will be making poppies, we will use a variety of art and craft materials to do this.

Wednesday: Today is 'Show and Tell'. The children are invited to bring a firework picture into the nursery that they have made at home.

In small groups this morning we will be working on our Bonfire counting paper. This will help the children to recognise their numbers.

The children will have the chance to take it in turns to play a game called 'Initial sound game'.

Thursday: Today we will be focussing on looking at our initial sounds. Each child will have the opportunity to do this with a teacher.

Our activity this morning is to make poppies using paper plates. We will use paper plates, paint and tissue paper for this activity.

This afternoon we have forest school where the children will get a chance to make lavender bags and bird feeders.

Friday: We will be discussing Remembrance day and why it is so important to remember this day each year. In small groups we will be playing silly soup which is a sound game. The children will be looking at the sounds 's, a, t, m and d'.

This afternoon in small groups we will look at our colours. Following on from this we will be making fruit rockets. We will be talking about what fruits we are using and the colours they are also.
