Theme:

Thursday: This morning we will be going to Forest School where we will be making Lavender bags and bird feeders.

In the afternoon we will be using some props in our story sack. We will then use various craft materials to make a "Remembrance" Poppy wreath.

Friday: This morning we will talk about our favourite stories and read some books. We will then make some Poppies for Remembrance Sunday.

In the afternoon we will play a Letters and Sounds word chain game. We will then use some bricks to explore paint and colours.
