



Week Beginning: 5<sup>th</sup> November 2018

Theme: Fireworks

**Monday:** Today we will learn about fireworks night and how to be safe during this celebration. We will watch a short video to help us to understand.

Our adult focus activity this morning the children will be making junk model fireworks, we will use a variety of art and craft materials to do this.

During our afternoon session as a class we will be singing our jolly phonics. We will look at the sound of the week which is 'I'. In small groups we will be creating firework printing pictures.

**Tuesday:** Today is our forest school session where we will be having a go at making lavender bags and bird feeders. The children will get the chance to touch and smell the lavender putting it into their own special bag. We will also be singing number and counting songs. We will look at our number of the week which is '9'.

In the afternoon we will play kings treasure game, each child will get a turn to do this during the morning. As our adult focus activity this afternoon we will role play fire stations and we will learn about fire safety.

**Wednesday:** To start our morning session off, as a class we will sing jolly phonics and look at the sound of the week which is 'I'. In smaller groups we will play shape snap. How many shapes can the children recognise?

In the afternoon we will practise our number recognition and focus on our number of the week. Our adult focus activity is to draw pictures of our favourite things; we will talk about this while in our groups.

**Thursday:** This morning we will be creating collage poppies, we will use various art and craft materials to make them stand out. As a class we will create a number line.

In the afternoon we will read our book of the week which is 'How to catch a star'. In smaller groups for our adult focus activity we will be doing finger painting.

**Friday:** Today as a class we will learn about remembrance Sunday and the importance of the poppy. Following this in small groups we will be making hand print poppies. We will use red and black paint.

During the afternoon we have forest school where we will be making lavender bags and bird feeders. We will also be listening to a remembrance song to end the session.
