



Week Beginning: 5th November 2018

Theme: Fireworks

Monday: Today we will be learning about Guy Fawkes and the history that surrounds Bonfire night. During the morning the children will each get the opportunity to make a firework display using various materials.

As a class we will watch a short video about celebrating Bonfire night in the UK.

This afternoon we have forest school and the children will be making bird feeders using cheerio's and pipe cleaners. These will then be hung up in the trees.

Tuesday: As a class this morning we will be learning about the letter 'O' which is the letter of the week. We will be finding words starting with 'O' and singing nursery rhymes.

In small groups we will be trying some Oranges and discussing how they taste.

Do you like them? Are they sweet or sour?

As a group this afternoon we will be using number flashcards. We will look at numbers 1-10 counting out 8 items with 8 being our number of the week.

In small groups we will be making number cups. We will be matching numbers with quantity, recognizing numbers and practising counting during this activity.

Wednesday: This morning we have forest school, the children have the chance to help make lavender bags. The children will be able to touch and smell the lavender when putting it into their bags. We will be discussing this during the activity.

After forest school we will be practising singing number songs like '5 little monkeys'.

This afternoon we will be talking about our other letter of the week which is 'U'. We will be writing this down on the interactive boards.

We will be making paper plate umbrellas in small groups using paint and straws. The children will be talking about objects that begin with the letter 'U' while focussed on this activity.

Thursday: As a class activity this morning we will be discussing basic fire safety rules. How can we be safe? Do you know who to call if there is a fire?

Using the role play area we will be acting out fire emergency scenarios. We will be talking about fire fighters and who else help us.

In the afternoon we will be finding rhyming words and make a family of rhyming words. After this for our afternoon activity we will be playing phonic games on our interactive board. Can we match the letter to the correct sound?

Friday: Today is 'Show and tell' day so we are asking if the children can bring a poppy if they have one into nursery. We will be talking about Remembrance Sunday.

As a class we will be making poppies in small groups, we will use various art and craft materials to do this.

To start the afternoon session off we will talk about Remembrance Sunday with the children who have just come into nursery. We will play various games to help with turn taking and to help with understanding rules/instructions.
