



Week Beginning: 26th November 2018

Theme: Sending Letters

Monday: As a class this morning we will talk about people who are special to us. In small key groups the children will have the chance to create thanks giving collage pictures using various craft materials to do this. For our afternoon activity we will be making thank you cards and talking about what we are thankful for. As a whole group we will read the thank you cards we have made out to the class.

Tuesday: This morning we have forest school, the children will be creating mud pictures using, paint, food colouring, mud, sponges, root vegetables etc. This morning we will be singing our jolly phonics as a group and we will be focussing on our sound of the week which is 'L'. As a class this afternoon we will be write a class letter to Santa.

Wednesday: Today we will learn about the job of a Post person. We will discuss why we need them. In small groups we will use the wipe clean boards to continue helping form our letters correctly. As a group this afternoon we will be reading our book of the week which is 'The Jolly Postman'. We will practise writing our names, we will sound out the sounds within our names and then focus on forming each letter writing.

Thursday: This morning we will read our book of the wee "The Jolly Postman". We will then have some messy play fun with rainbow spaghetti. In the afternoon we will have a whole group sing along. We will be then be role playing post offices and practicing sending letters.

Friday: In the morning we will read our book of the week "The Jolly Postman". We will then make some snow flake pinecones. In the afternoon we will sing our Jolly phonic songs and focus on our letter of the wee which is "L". We will then be going out to Forest School and trying out an activity "painting with mud".
